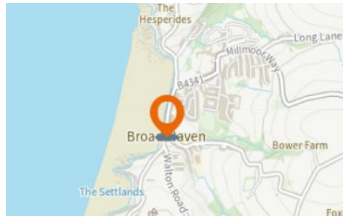

Vocabulary for this term's learning:

Urban	an area where lots of people live and work close together
Rural	an area that is not a town or city, often used for farming or agriculture
Human Feature	An attribute of the location that has been made or altered by human intervention.
Physical Feature	An attribute of land that has occurred naturally due to a natural process.
Demographic	The study of human population - how many people live in a certain area and how it has changed over time
Recreational Land	used for purposes of recreations to relax and play e.g. sports fields, gymnasiums, playgrounds, public beaches, camping sites.
Agricultural Land	used for the purpose of farming e.g. growing and harvesting crops and raising animals or livestock.
Residential Land	used for the purpose of housing.
Commercial Land	used for shops, businesses, factories and warehouses.

Facts:

- Broad Haven is a largely rural area whereas Swindon Village (Cheltenham) is much more urbanised.
- The distance between Swindon Village and Broad Haven is approximately 166 miles.

Facts about our field study locations:

Swindon Village:

- Swindon Village is both a village and a suburb in the spa town of Cheltenham, Gloucestershire, England.
- The parish had a population of 5,562 according to the 2021 census.
- Cheltenham is a large spa town and borough on the edge of the Cotswolds in the county of Gloucestershire, England.
- The town hosts several festivals of culture, often featuring nationally and internationally famous contributors and attendees.
- Cheltenham is the home of former Olympian Eddie Edwards and Arctic Explorer Edward Wilson.
- Cheltenham's largest physical feature is Cleeve Hill and has one main river (the river Chelt).

Broad Haven:

- Broad Haven is a village, together with Little Haven they form the Havens community and seaside resort in the South East corner of St Bride's Bay, South Pembrokeshire, Wales.
- The 2021 census records a population of 856 for Broad Haven.
- It is a seaside resort with a large west-facing Blue Flag beach offering safe bathing for families and good surfing, windsurfing and sailing opportunities.
- Broad Haven boasts a large range of physical features from cliffs and a sand beach to rock pools and off-coast islands.
- Broad Haven has lots of human features that attract tourists such as restaurants, shops, water sports and camp sites.
