English

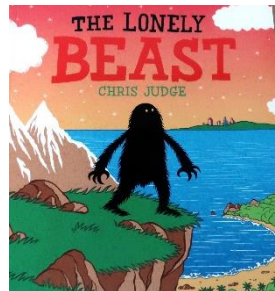
