- I will talk to my parents when asking to play games/use apps online. Before playing games/using apps I will ask an adult's permission.

- I will not download things that I know I shouldn't or go on websites that I know I shouldn't be on. If I accidentally go on anything that I'm not sure about, I will go to an adult straight away.

- I will not send anyone anything that could make people feel uncomfortable, upset or get them into trouble.

- I will not delete, change or access any of my friends work when using technology in school.

- I will not give out any personal information online, such as my name, phone number or address.

- I will not reveal my passwords to anyone other than my parents/carers/school staff.

- I will not arrange a face-to-face meeting with someone I meet online unless I am accompanied by a trusted adult. If anyone suggests a face-to-face meeting, I will tell a member of SVPS staff or my parent/carer.

- If I am concerned or upset about anything I see on the internet or any messages that I receive, I know I can talk to my parents/carers/teachers.

I understand that my internet use at Swindon Village Primary School will be monitored and logged and can be made available to my teacher. I understand that these rules are designed to keep me safe and that if I choose not to follow them, Swindon Village Primary School may contact my parents/carers.
