Young person's agreement

- I will be responsible for my behaviour whenever using the internet, including social media platforms, games and apps. This includes the resources I access and the language I use.
- I will discuss the PEGI (age) rating of games and apps that I want to use and ask permission from my parent/carer to use these.
- I will not deliberately browse, download or upload material that could be considered offensive or illegal. If I accidentally come across any such material, I will report it immediately to an adult.
- I will not send anyone material that could be considered threatening, bullying, offensive or illegal.
- When using technology (particularly in school) I will not access, edit or delete the files of anyone else unless given permission by an appropriate adult.
- I will not give out any personal information online, such as my name, phone number or address.
- I will not reveal my passwords to anyone other than my parents/carers/school staff.
- I will not arrange a face-to-face meeting with someone I meet online unless I am accompanied by a trusted adult. If anyone suggests a face-to-face meeting, I will tell a member of SVPS staff or my parent/carer.
- If I am concerned or upset about anything I see on the internet or any messages that I receive, I know I can talk to my parents/carers/teachers.

I understand that my internet use at Swindon Village Primary School will be monitored and logged and can be made available to my teacher. I understand that these rules are designed to keep me safe and that if I choose not to follow them, Swindon Village Primary School may contact my parents/carers.
